The Salisbury University Campus Mediation Center is looking for students interested in being trained as mediators in the field of conflict resolution. Mediators are required to attend the full 50-hour training. After completing the training, peer mediators make a long-term commitment to the Peer Mediation Program. Mediators are required to volunteer for a minimum of one year or 84 hours in outreach projects, volunteering, and conducting mediations. The training is free and this is a great opportunity for students to gain skills that are valuable in life and in the work place. Upon completion of the training and apprenticeship, you will receive a certificate from the Center for Conflict Resolution. In addition to this, you will be certified by Maryland Association of Community Mediation Centers (MACMC) allowing you to mediate in the state of Maryland.
